Founded in 1994 as a contract packager specializing in tableting and encapsulating to the small- and medium-sized dietary supplement market, NPRI has grown into a global supplier of nutritional bioactives to the food, food supplement, personal care, pet food and animal feed industries.

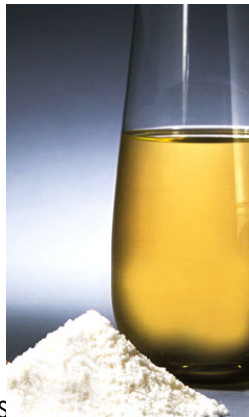
Key to this transformation has been development of a unique oil-to-powder conversion process first introduced in 1997.

Coined "O2P™", this process was unlike any existing conversion process currently available. Until this time, most technologies utilized extremes in heat (or cold) to aid in the bonding of the oil and carrying agent.

Scientists at NPRI recognized that extreme heat or cold significantly altered the molecular structure of the oil, reducing or destroying the active nutrients.

In addition, existing processes were conducted at normal

atmospheric pressure, thus increasing the potential for oxidation and increased peroxide values. They also established that existing spray dry or micro-encapsulated powders could only contain a limited amount of oil, thus reducing the nutrition value of the oil in a powder form.



O2P™ was designed to ensure that the integrity of the oil remains the same throughout the conversion process, yet delivers a free-flowing powder that is compatible with most dry mix production processes.

With O2P™, food and food supplement marketers can turn nutrition into healthy food, by adding an omega-3, Vitamin E or other nutrient. Likewise, personal care product producers can turn a cosmetic into skin care by adding an anti-oxidant or skin replenishers such as amino acids.

O2P™ uses a gravity flow process that is conducted in an oxygen-free environment. Process enhancements in 2003 and again

in early 2004 now deliver a powder with the capacity to hold nearly 70% oil content vs. 40% from other technologies. Carrying agents have been improved to now offer GMO-free, starch, vegetable-based, and other alternatives.

NPRI is currently transitioning its business away from its roots in the highly competitive, low margin tableting and contract packaging segment into the high margin and explosive growth markets of food fortification and personal care product enrichment.

In November, 2003, the company officially reorganized as Nutri Pharmaceutical Research, Inc. (NPRI) and commenced trading on the Pink sheets under the symbol "NRIP". At this time, there are currently more than 70 million shared authorized and approximately 12.3 million issued. In December, 2004, the company filed a 10SB with the SEC and initiated trading on the NASDAQ OTC BB.
